Dr John ‘Shad’ Linley
Speaks on plans to double the Townsville
Sun Metals zinc refinery, the Central Old
Light Metals plan and a fresh nickel project
for the Greenvale field and Townsville

What better way to celebrate Christmas than with a feast of information! Shad Linley is *the* leading architect of the long-term mineral industrialisation of Queensland. After helping identify the opportunity for the US\$425M Sun Metals refinery he brought it to Korea Zinc. He supervised the 200,000tpa project’s construction and is working on plans to double it to 400,000tpa. His stellar CV spans Vice President of Texas Gulf, executive positions with Fluor Engineers and Constructions to Executive Sponsor of the Olympic Dam project. A native of Wisconsin, he was first conscripted to draft Queensland’s future when he launched and operated the Queensland’s ‘Centre for Strategic Industrial and Resources Initiative’. This industry-government group brought together the Central Queensland Light Metals Centre Concept, a regional plan for magnesium-aluminium-titanium around Gladstone and Rocky. Then came the plans for Townsville as a refining centre of the future. The heart of Shad’s address will cover little-heralded Sun Metals project and its big growth plans. He’ll also bring us the latest on coal bed methane from the Bowen and Gallilee basins in a pictorial and entertaining SMC Christmas bash.

“I hate small companies” says Linley of Metallica Minerals which he now chairs “but this one was so good I had to get involved”. With the Greenvale nickel province laterites tied up, plans to Pressure Acid Leach and a glut of acid from the zinc refineries, Metallica is ready for IPO, get your prospectus on the day. Things are jumping in the Deep North. Catch up with all the latest in one hit! Not to be missed!
