## June 2007 Field Conference

Kilkivan – Mt Rawdon – Cracow

23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> June 2007

*Three days of rocks, core, minesites, discussions and good company*

### Day One - Gympie, Kilkivan, Goomeri and District.

Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2007 - Leaving from the Transit Centre, Roma Street Brisbane at 8am we will proceed to Gympie where outcrops of the Permian Gympie Province will be viewed. Heading on to Kilkivan we will visit the d'Aguilar Gold site at Black Snake where cores and rock specimens of Mt Cobalt and Anduramba drilling will be displayed. Lunch at Kilkivan after which we will proceed through Tansey to Gayndah passing through sections of the Esk Trough Volcanics.

### Day Two - Cracow and District.

Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2007 – Travel through Eidsvold where we will see rocks of the Eidsvold igneous complex, on to Cracow to visit examples of the key elements of the Cracow area, view selected cores from recent drilling in the mine area and visit sites within the Permian volcanic suite. We will return to Gayndah that evening.

### Day Three – Mt Rawdon, Mt Perry and District.

Monday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2007 – From Gayndah we will travel to Mt Rawdon Mine where we will view the open pit and see examples of core from the area. After lunch we will see examples of the numerous granites in the Mt Perry area and the historical Mt Perry mining area before returning to Brisbane via Biggenden expecting to arrive in Brisbane Transit Centre at about 7pm.
