THE TERRY LEACH SCHOLARSHIP FOR POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH IN PETROLOGY & GEOCHEMISTRY

A one-off scholarship to the value of A\$20,000 is offered by Hellman & Schofield Pty Ltd to honour the life and work of Terry Leach BSc (Carleton University), MSc (Hons 1, Auckland University), M.Soc.Econ.Geol. Terry passed away on 28 February, 2007.

It is available to citizens of Australia or New Zealand who are members of the Australian Institute of Geoscientists (AIG) or the Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy (AusIMM) to assist with their PhD research at an overseas university. The PhD topic should be in the general area of the geochemistry, mineralogy and petrology of hydrothermal alteration associated with the formation of mineral deposits such as porphyry coppers, carbonate base-metal/epithermal/high-sulphidation precious metal deposits or Carlin-type gold systems.

The scholarship may be used to fund a duration of research whilst undertaking PhD research in Australia or New Zealand and can be used for expenses associated with field work, travel or study. Applicants should be under 30 years of age. The successful candidate is expected to publish their research in journals of international reputation.
