TOPIC: "In Search of a Red (Metal) Giant: From the Cosmic to Prospect Scale"

This talk highlight the importance of using of all scales of data in the search for a giant iron oxide copper, gold (and uranium) deposit. How was copper formed in the universe? What makes a good IOCG target, and why Red Metal is the stock to hold.

Rob Rutherford is a geologist with over 17 years Australian and international exploration experience and has been involved in generative, feasibility and management roles in the copper, gold and base metal exploration industry.
