RELEVANT EXPERIENCE:

I have 30 years continuous experience as a geologist in mineral exploration for gold, base metals, platinum, and diamonds in the Archaean, Proterozoic and Phanerozoic terrains of Australia. My roles have included grass roots exploration, brown fields and mine based exploration, in mine exploration, mine production geology and project management of new gold mine development.

UNITY MINING LTD. January 2013 to October 2014.

Project Manager/Acting General Manager Dargues Gold Mine, Exploration Manager.

Unity Mining and Cortona Resources merged in January 2013 and I transferred to Unity Mining to continue managing the Dargues Gold Mine. My duties as Project Manager/Acting General Manager included managing the excavation of the boxcut and construction of the access road and the ongoing development of the mine. Additional duties included liaison with government departments, community liaison, development and implementation of site safety management plan, contractor management, and management of site staff.

My role as Project Manager finished at the end of May 2013 upon appointment of the Mine General Manager.

As Exploration Manager, I was responsible for the exploration and management of the Company's NSW tenements. This involved continuation of exploration programs underway prior to the commencement of the development of the Dargues Gold Mine and generation of new targets through geochemical and geophysical prospecting. Exploration completed resulted in the identification of a new style of mineralisation for the area and numerous new exploration targets in the near mine area.

CORTONA RESOURCES LTD. July 2007 to January 2013.

Senior Exploration Geologist, Exploration Manager, Project Manager/Acting General Manager.

I commenced as a Senior Exploration Geologist managing and conducting exploration on the Majors Creek Project, primarily Dargues Reef. Duties included planning, implementing and managing drilling programs, data management and interpretation, geological interpretation, managing field staff, community liaison, land access negotiations, company and statutory reporting, tenement management, managing environmental impact of exploration activities, budget preparation and management.

In early 2009 I was promoted to Exploration Manager – East to manage exploration of Cortona’s NSW tenements. The focus of exploration activities was Dargues Reef and near mine exploration around Majors Creek. Duties included the above and commencing community consultation and preparation for the Dargues Reef Feasibility study and Environmental Assessment. During 2010 I managed the Dargues Reef resource drill out, managed on site activities for the feasibility study and environmental assessment.

In late 2010 I was promoted to Project Manager – Dargues Reef to manage onsite activities associated with developing the Dargues Reef Gold Mine. Duties included managing site safety, implementing the environmental monitoring program, assisting and providing support to numerous consultants, managing ongoing exploration, preparing scopes of work, obtaining tenders, assisting with design of the Boxcut, Access Road and site infrastructure, community consultation and implementation of Project Approval conditions. Other duties included exploration data management and reporting, weekly and monthly reports, managing budgets and schedules.

PEAK GOLD MINES, COBAR: November 2004 to June 2007.

Senior Exploration Geologist responsible for managing near-mine and regional exploration programs, data interpretation and presentation, budget preparation, supervision of staff and contract geologists, drilling and geophysical contractors, landholder liaison, project review and reporting. I was promoted to Exploration Superintendent in early 2007 to manage exploration and 2IC the Geology Superintendent.

From June 1998 till July 2000 I was working on regional basemetal exploration. From July 2000 to July 2001, I supervised the deep drilling programmes around the two mines. My position at the mine was made redundant due to budget reductions.

Achievements: Exploration success led to the delineation of the Gossan Hill zinc resources and recent additional zinc and copper resources, which have significantly extended the mine life.

- Gossan Hill Feasibility study involved - resource definition drilling of Archaean VHMS base metal mineralisation, database validation, geological and orebody interpretation and modelling using Vulcan/Envisage, resource estimation and reporting.
