This four and a half day course is designed to provide practical tools and skills that will allow exploration and mining professionals, to identify and describe ore textures and breccias in mineralised systems and porphyry/skarn deposits. The course is split into two modules which can be attended separately and the course emphasis is on, skills that can be readily applied in the field and to drill core. Graduate geologists who need to build their practical skills and those needing a refresher will gain the most from this course.

This course is presented as part of the MTEC Honours program -participants will be studying alongside Honours students.
