Erwin Scheibner made a huge contribution to NSW geology and he influenced much exploration thinking. Erwin passed away in Rylstone in late June. He was in a nursing home after having a stroke some years ago.

Erwin essentially introduced plate tectonics to the interpretation of eastern Australia and made substantial contributions on the world stage including to the IUGS Circum-Pacific tectonic map.
