

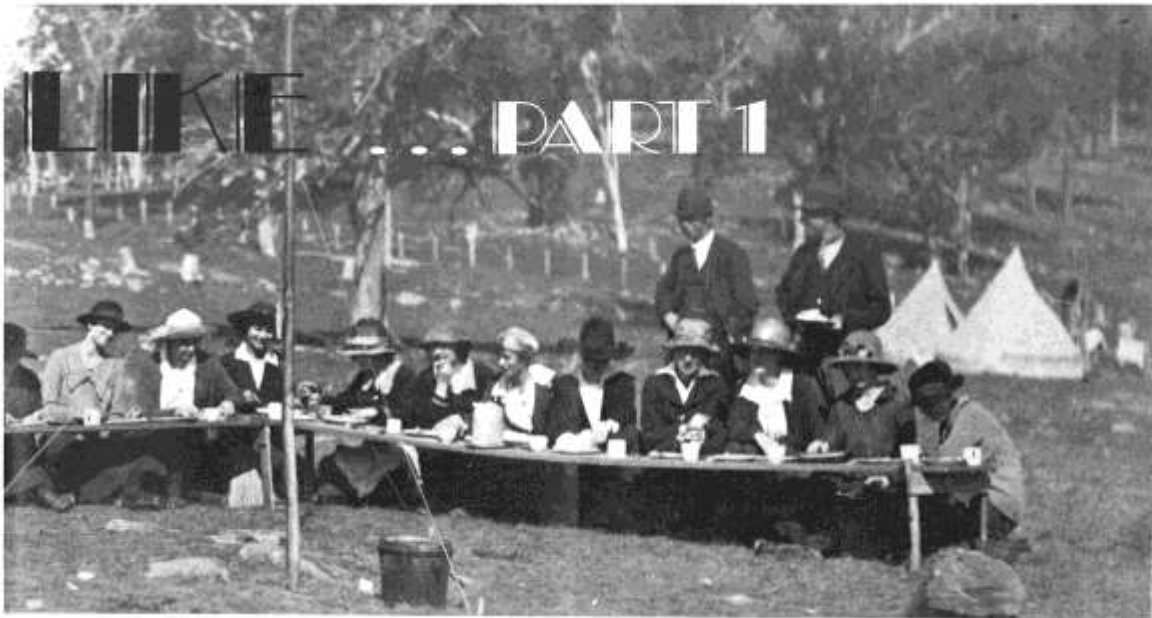

Consider the Antarctic issue for 1959 - Edgeworth David is in the middle, 1908-9 expedition. He was celebrated again in 1968.



The two photos below appeared across the banner of The Gazette, a publication of the University of Sydney; this issue was Vol 4, no. 4 for Sept 1982. They show Edgeworth David at left, in 1920, serving breakfast at Gosforth, in the Hunter Valley, about 10km NW of Maitland.





The women shown were all geology students at Sydney University, and they were on a geological excursion, sleeping in Bell tents I note, which were used as camp gear in my scouting days of 1950-54.
