The Myall Project – towards the next major Cu-Au discovery in NSW

Pursuing encouraging copper results from historic diamond drilling at Myall, in 2021 Magmatic Resources drilled a single diamond hole at the Kingswood Prospect, returning an interval 382 metres at 0.20% Cu. Following a subsequent review of the potential of the broader region, diamond drilling at the nearby Corvette Prospect commenced in July 2022, with the first completed hole returning a massive, mineralised interval of 722.5 metres at 0.25% Cu, 0.05g/t Au & 14ppm Mo from immediately below the cover sequence. A second hole drilled immediately to the north returned another very large interval of 413.4 metres at 0.26% Cu, 0.08g/t Au & 21ppm Mo from the base of cover. Most recently, partial results from the third completed hole at Corvette have delivered the best interval to date, comprising 154.6 metres at 0.47% Cu, 0.10g/t Au & 26ppm from the base of cover - with assays for the majority of this hole still pending. Exploration is ongoing at Myall, with Magmatic recently committing to a program of at least 8,000 metres of diamond drilling to unlock the potential of Corvette and surrounding prospects.

Adam McKinnon is a mining and exploration geologist with 16 years industry and academic experience and is currently the Managing Director of Magmatic Resources Limited. Adam holds a PhD in mineralogy and geochemistry from Western Sydney University, with particular expertise on the gold and base metal deposits of central western New South Wales
