

Dr Geoff Derrick – G.M.Derrick Geology



Geoff Derrick graduated with Honours and PhD from UQ 1963/1978, and worked with BMR-AGSO (the Federal earth science agencies) 1964-1980 in the Kimberley and Mt Isa regions. He moved to Brisbane and joined Tenneco 1980-85, then consulted in Australia and overseas from 1986 to 2015. He has specialised in the Mt Isa Inlier and their Pb-Zn deposits, and visited the Sullivan and Red Dog mines in the US. Consulting occurred in Namibia, Pakistan, USA, Canada and PNG, and presentations made to international conferences in Australia, Paris, Canada and the USA. He edited the Stockex Report for many years 1990 to 2005, and conducted numerous Geotours and workshops covering the Mt Isa Inlier over a decade or more from 2000.

Now semi-retired, Geoff is involved in the mentoring of young geologists, and in championing Earth Science. Current interests include a dedication to climate skepticism, managing an expanding hobby of stamp collecting and bromeliad propagation, and classifying and organizing an extensive rock/ mineral collection.
