I attended the GEOFEST 2024 workshop and dinner at Sydney University last Thursday, of which SMEDG/AIG/GSA/AusIMM were major sponsors. It was a great success, and Mike Leggo and Ian Neuss were on the organising committee. It was a collaborative event with ~100 attendees and presentations on both Indonesian and Australian Geotourism initiatives.

The 'take home message' was that the Indonesians are way ahead of us, having established 10 Geoparks while we are yet to open our first one ! Due to the high density of their population, many of their Geoparks are close to major population centres and act as community recreation parks as well, and are not based mainly on geological features or landscapes as ours will be.
