

GEOLOGIST GUIDE WANTED FOR KIMBERLEY GEOTOUR

2026 GEOTOURISM PILOT: *The Kimberley and the Crumple Zone*

Australia has many fascinating geological formations but geotourism in this country is still in its nascent stage. A pilot project is proposed for the Kimberley region in WA in 2026 to address this situation.

The Kimberley has been chosen as it's a region that is already well known for its fascinating and colourful formations, bringing many tourists to the region. The Kimberley is crying out for geological interpretation to service this audience.

A coach-supported geotour is proposed with an on-board geologist, so these questions can be answered.

Selection criteria for a suitable geologist are as follows:

Essential:

1. Working knowledge of the geology and landscapes of the Kimberley.
2. Superior science communication skills and/or tour guide experience.
3. Availability for a 7-9 day coach tour in 2026 (outside summer months).

Desirable:

1. Ability to research and communicate flora and fauna features of the Kimberley.
2. Field project management skills.
3. Willingness to participate in developing and disseminating the pilot evaluation.
