The monthly SMEDG Technical Meeting on 24 September 2026 will officially launch SMEDG GeoMatch featuring short 'pitch' presentations from companies and academics as well as a Q&A session for students, with all welcome to attend.

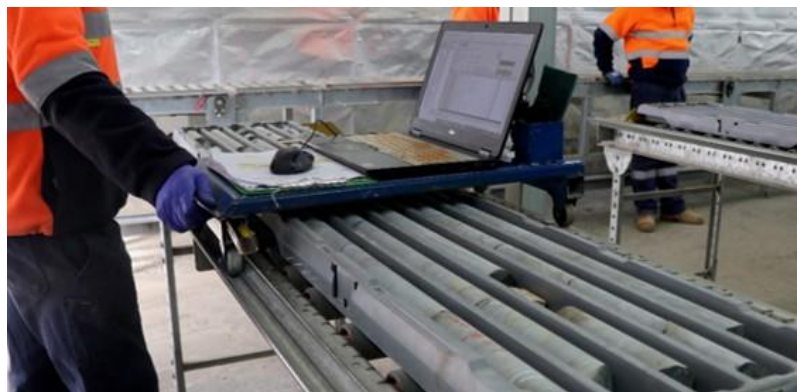
